KEY GLOBAL INITIATIVES



89% of **Brown-Forman's** electricity use is from renewable sources, including our partnership with East Fork Wind in the U.S., and rooftop solar at our **Slane Distillery** and Newbridge bottling facility in Edinburgh, Scotland.



Casa Herradura is part of a local micro-watershed restoration project within the Santiago-Guajalajara River Basin called Charco Bendito.



Starting in 2024, we switched our **Jack Daniel's** and **Woodford Reserve** 50mL bottles in travel retail to 100% PCR PET bottles.



In 2025 we announced a collaboration with Kentucky Distillers Association and Precision Conservation Management on a five-year, \$2.8 million initiative for **regenerative practices with Kentucky corn farmers**.



We've established **white oak tree nurseries** and completed native habitat restoration on more than 100 acres across our distilleries in Kentucky, Tennessee, and Ireland.

2025
